REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR PUERTO RICO SHIPMENTS

When shipping to Puerto Rico. There are two required documents that must be handed to the driver at time of pickup.

1. Bill of Lading

Please write your tax bond number or tax-exempt identification on the BOL.

2. Commercial Invoice

Although shipments to Puerto Rico don't need to clear customs, they are subject to excise/sales tax based on the value of the goods (noted in the commercial invoice).

For more information, call the U.S. Customs and Border Protection office in San Juan at 729-6850 or 787-729-6980. Keep in mind that because Puerto Rico is a territory of the U.S., there are no Customs and Border Protection formalities involved in trade or travel between the U.S. mainland and Puerto Rico.
